



PRACTISE A SKIT OR PLAY, AND PERFORM IT FOR A FAMILY MEMBER OR FILM IT TO SEND TO GRANDPARENTS

This is a simple cute skit appropriate for 4–10 year olds that Grandparents will like (OR MAKE UP YOUR OWN!) Practise it and get them to organise costumes and props to pass the time.

THE PARACHUTE SHOP!

Set the Scene: A sporting goods store –

Cast: A person working in parachute shop and a Customer (or two)

Optional Props: Little backpack with three cords dangling from it (parachute) and a ‘parachute sale!’ sign

The customer walks up to the counter and asks to see the range of parachutes.

Shop person: Well, we have a pretty big variety, what colour do you want?

Customer: Ummm ... purple

Shop person: What size do you want – small, medium or large?

Customer: Well ... medium I suppose

Shop person: Do you want new one ... or second hand one ... or the experimental option (these haven't been tested but they are cheaper)

Customer: This is ridiculous!!! I want a new one of course!! – I want to survive this jump! In fact just give me the best one you have in the shop.

Shop person: Well ... ok this is probably our best one. (Hands it to customer.)

Customer: What makes this one the best?

Shop person: Well, see here, this is the rip cord. That's what you pull when you want it to open it so you can float down"

Customer: Yeah?

Shop person: When you pull that, the parachute opens.

Customer: What's this other cord here?

Shop person: That's the emergency cord, in case the first one doesn't open the parachute, you have a back-up.

Customer: Ok ... What's the third cord for?

Shop person: That's the back up emergency cord. It's the back-up to the back-up.

Customer: Oh ... Ok ... But what if all three of them don't open?

Shop person: Don't worry – If you bring it back to the shop and we will give you a full refund!
